MEET THE CHARACTERS

BROOKLYN PAYNE is an award winning tattoo artist who has been in the industry for over 20 years. With a waiting list of celebrity clients who only allow their bodies to be touched by Payne's needle, he's been flown across the US and around the world to meet them at the drop of a hat. His tattoo work is done with perfection so anything he does - from the small and simple to the large and extremely detailed - is flawless every time. He puts his pride and dignity in every piece so the client will be proud to look upon their skin art their entire lives. Payne specializes in real life and portrait tattoos (one of the more difficult styles to master) so his work has extra meaning for the many clients who get their family and loved ones tattooed in memorial.

AMY NICOLETTO is a tattoo artist and television personality most known for her appearances on the TLC reality television show LA Ink. Though she has only been tatttooing for 8 years she has a unique style, as she was an artist long before she was a tattoo artist. Portraits, Japanese, color, traditional -- she is comfortable and willing to do any style, and opts to not confine herself when it comes to her art. When not on the road with Payne, Nicoletto tours with several tattoo shows including the Villain Arts Tattoo Shows, Ink Life Tour, and others. Between conventions and shows, she is often on the road guest spotting in various locations around the USA. Nicoletto's favorite tattoo styles include black-and-gray portraits, Japanese-influenced tattoos and just about anything with color.





<u>NIKKI</u> is Payne's Assistant with the hope to one day apprentice with him. She is well versed in the industry having grown up around it. She joins Payne on the road helping to maintain his tattoo station and assist him with his clients. Nikki can also be a bit of a wildcard, speaking out of line and often jumping before looking but is living life to the fullest. When not on the road, Nikki is a model and dancer.






PAINTED AMERICA WITTH BROOKLYN PAYNE

Show Segments / Points of Interest and Conflict








Artist Interviews - Payne highlights 1-2 artists in the shop, looks at their work, talks about their technique and what makes them stand out from the tattoo crowd.





Personal Conflict -Every episode we'll find out a little more about where each character is coming from and where they are going.

- *PAYNE is trying to maintain his family life while almost never actually being at home AND relocate his family to the other side of the country. On top of that he can get called away at a moment's notice by a celebrity client, adding to the stress of his road crew and his family.
- *TREVOR is about to be married and is working on planning the wedding while also maintaining Payne's career and personal life.



*AMY is always hustling to find the next big opportunity which can sometimes distract her from the work at hand.





Local Flavor - Every episode the crew will go on an adventure segment in the city they are in. Whether it's an odd landmark, a search for an urban legend or just checking out the local subculture, Payne will search out the oddest and coolest aspects of the city.





Payne's Fusion Art Project - Every artist the crew meets along the way will be invited to paint a portion of a giant painting with the theme of 'Hope' being the tying factor in the piece. At the end of the trip, the painting will be auctioned off and the proceeds with go to a Children's Cancer Charity.

Final Thought - Payne reflects on the events of the episode and what's to come on the road ahead.
